

## **Pigmeat Recall Scheme**

### **Trader Notice No. 07/2009**

#### **PORK PRODUCTS CONTAINING FOREIGN PIGMEAT INGREDIENTS**

---

Following a review of the eligibility of pork products containing foreign pigmeat under the Pigmeat Recall Scheme, the Department can now confirm the following:

Where an interim or final claim is being made in respect of **secondary pork product** which was manufactured using a mix of possibly contaminated pigmeat (from animals slaughtered in Ireland between 1<sup>st</sup> September and 6<sup>th</sup> December 2008) and imported pigmeat, the pork product concerned may, in its entirety, be regarded as eligible for assistance.

Processors are reminded that any declarations made regarding the eligibility of product must be verifiable by record and to the satisfaction of the Minister.
